Rom 11:25 For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

Rom 11:26 And so <u>all Israel shall be saved</u>: as it is written, there shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:

Rom 11:27 For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.

I. Israel Defiled The Land

Eze 36:17 Son of man, when the house of Israel dwelt in their own land, they defiled it by their own way and by their doings: their way was before me as the uncleanness of a removed woman.

Eze 36:18 Wherefore I poured my fury upon them for the blood that they had shed upon the land, and for their idols wherewith they had polluted it:

Eze 36:19 And I scattered them among the heathen, and they were dispersed through the countries: according to their way and according to their doings I judged them.

Eze 36:20 And when they entered unto the heathen, whither they went, they profaned my holy name, when they said to them, these are the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of his land.

a. Departed from YAHWEH and walked their own way: the way of a menstruous woman

Isa 64:6 But we are all as **an unclean thing**, and all our righteousnesses are as **filthy rags**; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.

Note: both Eze 36:17 and Isa 64:6 refer to the 'tame' [Hebrew for uncleanness'] of the menstrual ['ed in Hebrew] flow of a woman ['niddah' in Hebrew]

- b. Shedding innocent blood: sacrificing their babies to Baal [abortion]
- c. Idolatry
- d. Polluted the land
- e. Scattered among the heathen
- f. Profaned His holy Name among the heathen

II. Prophecy To the Mountains of Israel

Eze 36:1 Also, thou son of man, <u>prophesy unto the mountains of Israel</u>, and say, Ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the LORD:

Eze 36:2 Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because the enemy hath said against you, aha, even the ancient high places are ours in possession:

Eze 36:3 Therefore prophesy and say, thus saith the Lord GOD; Because they have made you desolate, and swallowed you up on every side, that ye might be a

possession unto the residue of the heathen, and ye are taken up in the lips of talkers, and are an infamy of the people:

Eze 36:4 Therefore, ye mountains of Israel, hear the word of the Lord GOD; Thus, saith the Lord GOD to the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers, and to the valleys, to the desolate wastes, and to the cities that are forsaken, which became a prey and derision to the residue of the heathen that are round about.

Eze 36:5 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Surely in the fire of my jealousy have I spoken against the residue of the heathen, and against all <u>Idumea</u>, which have appointed my land into their possession with the joy of all their heart, with despiteful minds, to cast it out for a prey.

Eze 36:6 Prophesy therefore concerning the land of Israel, and say unto the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers, and to the valleys, thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I have spoken in my jealousy and in my fury, because ye have borne the shame of the heathen:

Eze 36:7 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; I have lifted up mine hand, Surely the heathen that are about you, they shall bear their shame.

Eze 36:8 But ye, <u>O mountains of Israel</u>, <u>ye shall shoot forth your branches</u>, <u>and yield your fruit to my people of Israel</u>; for they are at hand to come.

- a. The enemies of Israel [particularly Idumea "edomites"] had exulted in possessing the Holy Land
- b. They made it desolate. The famous author Mark Twain wrote in 1867 during his visit to Palestine:

""Palestine sits in sackcloth and ashes. Over it broods the spell of a curse that has withered its fields and fettered its energies."

- c. YAHWEH's jealousy and fury aroused by the exultation of Israel's enemies.
- d. He commands the mountains to be fruitful to His people
- e. Indeed, when you visit Israel, you will be told of the miraculous transformation of the barren land: mountains, valleys and deserts have bloomed and blossomed.

"Our tour guide was particularly proud of her nation's excellent water management. They use drip irrigation to minimize evaporation, using 85% recycled water. They even use a reservoir of slightly brackish water located 150 meters below the Negev to water salt tolerant plants (like olive trees).

As a result, Israel is one of the only places on earth that is reclaiming desert areas. In 1964, Israel was 84% desert; now it is only 62% desert. Israel sees this as a fulfilment of Isaiah 35:1-2, "The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose. It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing. . . ."

Isa 43:19 Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.

Isa 43:20 The beast of the field shall honour me, the dragons and the owls: because I give waters in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert, to give drink to my people, my chosen.

Joe 3:18 And it shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all the rivers of Judah shall flow with waters, and a fountain shall come forth of the house of the LORD and shall water the valley of Shittim.

Isa 27:6 He shall cause them that come of Jacob to take root: Israel shall blossom and bud and fill the face of the world with fruit.

f. Israel is one of the world's leading fresh citrus producers and exporters, including oranges, grapefruit, tangerines and a hybrid of a grapefruit and a pomelo, developed in Israel. More than forty types of fruit are grown in Israel.

III. Prophecy To The Dry Bones

Eze 37:4 Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.

Eze 37:5 Thus saith the Lord GOD unto these bones; **Behold, I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live:**

Eze 37:6 And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

Eze 37:21 And say unto them, thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will take the children of Israel from among the heathen, whither they be gone, and will gather them on every side, and bring them into their own land:

Eze 37:22 And <u>I will make them one nation</u> in the land upon the mountains of Israel; and one king shall be king to them all: and they shall be no more two nations, neither shall they be divided into two kingdoms any more at all:

Eze 37:23 <u>Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will save them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be my people, and I will be their God.</u>

- a. In 1948 Israel was reborn as a nation, fulfilling this prophecy in part
- b. No more division into two nations
- c. Not yet fulfilled: removal of idolatry and sins.
- d. Not yet fulfilled: all Israel acknowledging YAHWEH as their God

IV. Israel Shall Know YAHWEH Elohim

Eze 39:22 So the house of Israel shall know that I am the LORD their God from that day and forward.

<u>Eze 39:28</u> Then shall they <u>know that I am the LORD their God</u>, which caused them to be led into captivity among the heathen: but I have gathered them unto their own land and have left none of them anymore there.

YAHWEH's miraculous intervention to defeat the armies of Gog-Magog will open the eyes of the Israelites to the God of Abraham. Isaac and Jacob.

V. The Gentile Nations Shall Know YAHWEH Elohim

Eze 38:23 <u>Thus will I magnify myself and sanctify myself; and I will be known</u> in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD.

VI. Israel Shall Know Yashua as Messiah

Rev 1:7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and <u>they also</u> <u>which pierced him</u>: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

Zec 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

Zec 12:11 In that day shall there be a great mourning in Jerusalem, as the mourning of Hadadrimmon in the valley of Megiddon.

Joe 2:31 The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come.

Joe 2:32 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the LORD hath said, and in the remnant whom the LORD shall call.

- a. At the Rapture, the Israelites will recognise Yeshua as Messiah when He displays His sign in the Heavens and appears in glory
- b. The 144,000 will be sealed and protected up to the 5th/6th Trumpet iudgments
- c. When Yeshua sets foot on the Mount of Olives to vanquish the Antichrist and the armies of the world, a remnant of I/3 of Israel will be saved.

VII. Messiah Shall Reign in Jerusalem

Eze 37:27 My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Eze 37:28 And the heathen shall know that I the LORD do sanctify Israel, when my sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore.
