1Pe 1:22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

1Pe 1:23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth forever.

1Pe 1:24 For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

1Pe 1:25 But the word of the Lord endureth forever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.

1Jn 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

1Jn 3:5 And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.

1Jn 3:6 Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him.

1Jn 3:7 Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

1Jn 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

1Jn 3:9 Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

I. Previous Message: Sin Not Unto Death

- a. Sin is the transgression of the Law. The AntiChrist is also called “The Lawless One” “the Man of Sin”
- b. Whoever commits [doeth...continuous tense, abides in, practices sin] is of the devil

II. Born Again Christians Do Not Commit Sin

We sin because of weakness of the flesh but we repent and confess. As we grow spiritually, we should sin less and less.

III. Abiding in Him

1Jn 3:6 Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither known him.

- a. Abide: ‘meno’ in Greek
- b. Those who persist in sin have not seen Him
- c. Those who persist in sin have not known Him

V. Characteristics of Born Again Christians

- a. Can see the Kingdom and its King

Joh 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

- b. Are lawful
- c. Learn to obey and know Him

Heb 5:8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered;

Heb 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

1Jn 2:4 He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

1Jn 2:5 But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him.

- d. Walk in the Spirit
- e. Overcome sin
- f. Manifest righteousness of Christ
- g. Purified Souls & Love the brethren

1Jn 3:14 We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loveth not his brother abideth in death.

1Pe 1:22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

- h. Willing to lay down our lives for the brethren

1Jn 3:16 Hereby perceive we the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.

- i. Willing to share our worldly goods with poor brethren

1Jn 3:17 But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother has need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him?

VI. How to be Born Again [David]

David's experience in Ps 51:

- a. dead in sin
- b. sinned terribly over almost a year
- c. obeyed YAHWEH's Torah selectively
- d. recognised that he could not erase the guilt and stain of sin
- e. cried out to YAHWEH for a clean heart and a new spirit
- f. recognised the need for brokenness before YAHWEH
- g. quickened by the Holy Spirit:

*Eph 2:5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath **quickened us** together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)*

Eph 2:6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

Eph 2:7 That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.

VII. How to be Born Again [Yeshua]

Joh 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

Joh 1:13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

Joh 3:4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?

Joh 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

Joh 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

Joh 3:7 Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Joh 3:8 The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

- a. Receive Yeshua, believe in Him

-Not merely intellectual agreement

-Trust and obey Him

*Heb 5:9 And being made perfect, **he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;***

- b. it is the work of the Holy Spirit
- c. the gift of God

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: **it is the gift of God:**

Eph 2:9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

d. Faith comes by hearing the Word of God:

Rom 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God.
