

Only One NAME Brings Salvation

Act 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

I. Thomas' Unbelief & Confession

Joh 20:24 *But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.*

Joh 20:25 The other disciples therefore said unto him, we have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.

Joh 20:26 And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you.

Joh 20:27 Then saith he to Thomas, reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

*Joh 20:28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, **My Lord and my God.***

Joh 20:29 Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast believed: blessed are they that have not seen and yet have believed.

- a. The apostle Thomas did not believe reports of Yeshua's resurrection
- b. Only when he saw the nail prints and put his hand on them and thrust his hand into the side of the risen Yeshua could he believe.
- c. His declaration 'My Lord and my God' acknowledged Yeshua as YAHWEH and God.

II. The Incomplete Gospel

1Co 15:1 *Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;*

1Co 15:2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.

1Co 15:3 ***For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;***

*1Co 15:4 **And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:***

1Co 15:47 *The first man is of the earth, earthy: **the second man is the Lord from heaven.***

- a. Preachers commonly preach only Yeshua as Savior who died on the cross for our sins and rose from the dead.
- b. They neglect 1 Co 15:47 where Paul declared Yeshua to be YAHWEH who came down from Heaven as a Man.

III. Romans 10:9

ESV Rom 10:9 because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

- a. Problem: the Greek word 'kurios' which is used for 'Lord' can mean master or God. Hence readers do not identify Yeshua as 'YAHWEH'
- b. Rom 10:9 should properly read 'if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is YAHWEH and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.'

IV. Power To Be Sons Of God

Joh 1:12 But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His Name:

What is His Name? It is not 'Jesus' because Jesus [Yeshua] means 'YAHWEH is salvation'. However, if you go to the Philippines there are any number of people named 'Jesus'. I had a friend with such a name, and we called him 'Jess' for short.

V. The Neglected Verse

Joh 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

The question is again: what is the Name of the only begotten Son of God?

VI. You Shall Die In Your Sins

Joh 8:24 I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am [he], ye shall die in your sins.

Note:

1. The 'he' in brackets does not exist in the Greek. Then it is clear, that the Name of Yeshua is 'I AM'
2. If we do not believe that Yeshua is "I AM" we shall die in our sins
3. Yeshua also declared:

Joh 8:58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I am."

4. The Greek word translated as 'am', is the word 'eimi' which means 'to be' 'to exist'
5. Compare with the Hebrew 'hayah asher hayer' translated as 'I AM THAT I AM' as in Exo 3:14-

*Exo 3:14 And God said unto Moses, **I AM THAT I AM**: and he said, Thus, shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.*

6. Please note that **we are commanded to say His Name**:

*1Ch 16:8 Oh give thanks to the LORD; **call upon His name**; make known His deeds among the peoples!*

1Ch 16:9 Sing to Him, sing praises to Him; tell of all His wondrous works!

*1Ch 16:10 **Glory in His Holy Name**; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice!*

7. Note that the Hebrew Bible of the Old Testament always uses 'Yehovah' as His Name and which translates to 'LORD' in English and capitalized.

VII. The Name YAHWEH

*Exo 3:15 And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, **The LORD God of your fathers**, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: **this is My Name for ever, and this is My memorial unto all generations.***

H3068 yehôvâh translated as 'LORD' in English.

BDB Definition:

Jehovah = "the existing One"

1) the proper name of the one true God

1a) unpronounced except with the vowel pointings of H136 [adonay]

1. Note:

Unfortunately, the Greek does not have the Tetragrammaton:

The Tetragrammaton (Greek for "four-letter word") refers to the divine name of God in the Hebrew Bible, represented by the four Hebrew consonants יהוה (YHWH/YHVH-reading from the left: **yod, he, waw, he**). Appearing 6412 times in the Hebrew Scriptures, it is considered the most sacred, ineffable name of God. That is why, out of reverence and fear, the Jews do not use the actual Name but use 'Hashem' [meaning: the Name] to refer to YAHWEH. Because of the lack of vowels, the original pronunciation is debated, though it is often rendered as Yahweh or Jehovah.

2. The Name 'YAHWEH' is everlasting

3. Every generation shall invoke The Name

VIII. INRI

*Joh 8:28 Then said Jesus unto them, **when ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am [he]**, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things.*

Note: the 'he' does not exist in the Greek text.

INRI is a Latin acronym for Iesus Nazarenus, Rex Iudaeorum ("Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews"). According to John 19:20, this phrase was displayed in Hebrew, Latin, and Greek above Jesus on the cross. The Hebrew translation used is ישוע הנצרי ומלך היהודים (Yeshua HaNatzri U'Melech HaYehudim).

Reading from the left, the first letters of the Hebrew words in the phrase—ישוע הנצרי—form the acronym יהוה (YHWH)

Hence, we can see the fulfillment of Yeshua's prophecy in Joh 8:28.

IX. My Father And I Are One

Joh 10:30 I and my Father are one.

Joh 10:31 Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.

Joh 10:32 Jesus answered them, many good works have I shewed you from my Father; for which of those works do ye stone me?

Joh 10:33 The Jews answered him, saying, for a good work we stone Thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that Thou, being a man, makest thyself God.

Note: Yeshua declared oneness with His Father, recalling

Deu 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God is one LORD:

No wonder the Pharisees sought to stone Him. He was declaring Himself to be YAHWEH, one with the Father.

X. At The Name Of Yeshua

Php 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him, and given Him a Name which is above every name:

Php 2:10 That at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

Php 2:11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Note: again the Greek word 'kurios' is translated as 'Lord' which means master but Php 2:9 clearly states that the name of Yeshua is above every name. That can only be 'YAHWEH'

XI. Deity of Christ

Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Joh 1:2 The same was in the beginning with God.

Joh 1:3 All things were made by Him; and without him was not anything made that was made.

Tit 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

Heb 1:8 But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of Thy Kingdom.

Note: Yeshua is 'the Word', God, and Creator, 'YAHWEH' and is King forever.

XII. There Is No Other Saviour

Isa 43:11 I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour.

Note: if Yeshua is not YAHWEH, there is no salvation. Our sins are transgressions against YAHWEH's Laws for which the penalty is eternal damnation. Our ransom requires YAHWEH Himself through His Son Yeshua who is also named YAHWEH to pay the eternal price of our redemption. There is no salvation in any other name.
