

YTVid-Know The Mystery of God's Will

I. Know His Will

Eph 5:16 Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

Eph 5:17 Wherefore be ye not unwise but understanding what the will of the Lord is.

Col 1:9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

Col 1:10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

Eph 1:9 Having made known unto us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He hath purposed in Himself:

Eph 1:10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:

- a. Wisdom is understanding the will of YAHWEH
- b. Knowledge of His will is necessary for fruitfulness and to increase our knowledge of God.
- c. The mystery of His will is that, in the fullness of time, Christ will gather all things in Heaven and on Earth unto Himself

II. Entry Into The Kingdom

Mat 7:21 Not everyone that saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven.

Mat 7:22 Many will say to Me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Thy name? and in Thy name have cast out devils? and in Thy name done many wonderful works?

Mat 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

Luk 12:47 And that servant, which knew his Lord's will, and prepared not himself, neither did according to His will, shall be beaten with many stripes.

Luk 12:48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

- a. Only those who do the Will of YAHWEH will enter the Kingdom of Heaven

- b. **Serving the Lord in preaching, prophesying and doing miracles is no substitute for obedience to His Will**
- c. **Lawlessness [disobedience to His Commandments] is iniquity. Those who indulge in iniquity will be cast out from His Presence [into Hell]**
- d. **Those who know His Will but violated it shall suffer many stripes [punishment]**
- e. **Those who do not know His Will and sin against Him will be punished but with fewer stripes.**
- f. **Basic spiritual principle: more is expected of those who know more**

III. Sanctification Necessary

1Th 4:3 For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:

1Th 4:4 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;

1Th 4:5 Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know not God:

1Th 4:6 That no man go beyond and defraud his brother in any matter: because that the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified.

1Th 4:7 For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.

- a. **Holiness [sanctification] is required of us. This means separation from the world and its works and values.**
- b. **Most Christians and churches only preach justification [what Yeshua did for us in His suffering, death and resurrection. Such Christians will never enter His Kingdom.**
- c. **Sanctification is the opposite of uncleanness.**
- d. **Uncleanness occurs when people eat unclean [forbidden] foods listed in Lev 11.**
- e. **Uncleanness also occurs in fornication which includes unclean and forbidden sexual activities like adultery, homosexuality, anal sex, bestiality, incest and unclean sex during a woman's menstruation [Lev 18].**

IV. Give Thanks

1Th 5:16 Rejoice evermore.

1Th 5:17 Pray without ceasing.

1Th 5:18 In everything give thanks: for this is the Will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

1Th 5:19 Quench not the Spirit.

1Th 5:20 Despise not prophesyings.

1Th 5:21 Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.

1Th 5:22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.

- a. Give thanks
- b. Do not quench the Holy Spirit
- c. Do not despise prophesying
- d. Test all things
- e. Hang on to what is spiritually good
- f. Do not present any appearance/behaviour that is evil

V. Believe In The Son

Joh 6:38 For I came down from Heaven, not to do Mine own Will, but the Will of Him that sent Me.

Joh 6:39 And this is the Father's Will which hath sent Me, that of all which He hath given me I should lose nothing but should raise it up again at the last day.

Joh 6:40 And this is the Will of Him that sent Me, that everyone which seeth the Son, and believeth on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

- a. Be like Yeshua: do YAHWEH's will
- b. It is YAHWEH's will that all the sheep entrusted to His Son will be kept safely and resurrected at the last Day
- c. All who see Yeshua and believe [trust and obey] Him will have everlasting life and be resurrected [at the First Resurrection].

VI. Practise Justice, Mercy, Humility

Mic 6:8 He hath shewed thee, O man, what is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?

- a. Practise justice
- b. Love mercy [be forgiving]
- c. Walk in humility

VII. To be Established On Earth

Mat 6:10 Thy Kingdom come. Thy Will be done in earth, as it is in Heaven.

- a. We are to pray for His Kingdom to be established on earth
- b. We are to learn to do His will as all in Heaven do
- c. Obviously, those who refuse to do His Will while on earth will not qualify for Heaven.

VIII. Keep Body Holy & Renew Mind

Rom 12:1 *I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.*

Rom 12:2 *And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, Will of God.*

- a. How can we know His will?
- b. Our bodies must be kept holy: a living sacrifice acceptable to God. Do not abuse our appetites nor indulge in our own desires.
- c. Do not be conformed to the world and its values/ideas
- d. We need to be transformed via the renewal of our minds by the Holy Spirit and Scripture.
- e. Only then will we know and understand the good, acceptable and perfect Will of God.

IX. Submission To Earthly Authorities

1Pe 2:13 *Submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake: whether it be to the king, as supreme;*

1Pe 2:14 *Or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by Him for the punishment of evildoers, and for the praise of them that do well.*

1Pe 2:15 *For so is the will of God, that with well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men:*

- a. We must submit to every ordinance of earthly leaders/governments, like obeying secular laws, paying our taxes, etc.
- b. The punishments decreed by secular laws are mandated by YAHWEH through the rulers appointed by Him

X. Belong To God's Family

Mar 3:33 *And He answered them, saying, who is My mother, or My brethren?*

Mar 3:34 *And He looked round about on them which sat about Him, and said, Behold My mother and My brethren!*

Mar 3:35 *For whosoever shall do the Will of God, the same is My brother, and My sister, and mother.*

- a. Yeshua did not acknowledge His earthly relatives as His relatives
- b. Only those who do the will of God will qualify to be His relatives

XI. God Listens To Him

Joh 9:31 *Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth His Will, him He heareth.*

- a. Do you want your prayers to be answered?

b. Do His Will!

XII. Yeshua Gave Himself

Gal 1:3 Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ,

Gal 1:4 Who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the Will of God and our Father:

- a. It was the Will of Father YAHWEH that Yeshua laid down His Life to save us
- b. We are also delivered from the present evil world that seeks to ensnare us.

XIII. Abiding Forever

1Jn 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

1Jn 2:17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the Will of God abideth for ever

- a. The lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life are of this world
- b. The world is transient and will be destroyed by Him
- c. Whoever does the Will of God will abide forever.
